**Lesson:** 2/4 What to do in case of fire



**Duration:** One lesson

Learning objectives:	Content:
1. Students are able to choose the right fire extinguisher.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Smoke is dangerous to health</li><li>• Using a fire extinguisher</li><li>• Grease fire</li><li>• Liquid fire</li><li>• Electrical fire</li><li>• Solid material fire</li><li>• Person on fire</li><li>• Battery fire</li><li>• Locations of fire extinguishers in the school and how to use them</li></ul>

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**Lesson:** 2/4 What to do in case of fire



**Duration:** One lesson

### Course of the lesson

#### START

- **Lecture:** In a fire, the air becomes life-threatening in minutes
- **Lecture:** Watch out, smoke is dangerous!
- Objectives of the lesson

#### 1. SECTION: Choosing the right fire extinguisher

- **Video:** Using a handheld fire extinguisher and fire hydrant.
- **Discuss:** What to do if grease, oil or stearin catches fire? Discuss with the class.
  - **Video:** Water causes a grease fire to explode and splatter.
- **Discuss:** What to do if a flammable liquid catches fire? Discuss with the class.
- **Discuss:** What to do if an electrical appliance catches fire? Discuss with the class.
- **Discuss:** What to do if a solid material catches fire? Discuss with the class.
- **Discuss:** What to do if your or someone else's clothes catch fire?
- **Discuss:** What to do if a battery is smouldering or giving off smoke? If a battery is on fire? Discuss with the class.
- **Task:** Find out where your school's fire extinguishers are located and how to use them.

#### SECTION 2: Protecting yourself from fire

- **Lecture:** Evacuation routes
- **Lecture:** If there is a fire in the apartment or house you are in, leave.
  - **Discuss:** If there was a fire in your home and the front door was blocked, how would you evacuate?
- **Game:** What to do if there is a fire elsewhere in the apartment building?
  - **Lecture:** If there is a fire elsewhere in the apartment building, stay in your home.
- **Game:** What to do if there is a fire in the neighbourhood?
  - **Lecture:** If there is a fire in the neighbourhood, stay in your home.
- **Lecture:** If there is a fire in a public space, follow the instructions you are given
  - **Task:** Can you find the exit sign in the classroom? Do you know at least two ways out of the school?
