



BEWARE OF BATTERY FIRES! (45–90 min)

OBJECTIVES

Pupils are familiar with the risks related to battery and electrical fires.

Pupils consider the risks related to their own actions and know how to act in order to prevent accidents.

SKILLS

Taking care of oneself, everyday skills, multiliteracy, digital skills

IMPLEMENTATION

First language, home economics, form tutor's class

EQUIPMENT

The teacher needs a computer and a video projector to ensure successful lessons. Pupils need tablet computers or smartphones, computers and a network connection

INFORMATION CONTENT

NouHätä! slides, lesson 1 Preventing fires 18-21

ORIENTATION 10-15 MIN.

To start the lesson, battery fires and their frequency are discussed with pupils in order to get an understanding of their knowledge. Next, pupils will familiarise themselves more closely with the phenomenon of battery fires by searching for news about battery fires and presenting one interesting piece of news to the class..
